Call for Papers

Overcoming the limits to growth and human development: Managerial Challenges - Asian and European Perspectives

Following a number of conferences held in France, Japan, Korea, Germany, Ireland, Norway, Italy, China, Spain, Indonesia and India since 1994, the Twenty Second International Euro-Asia Research Conference will take place in Parma (Italy) from June the 21st to the 23rd, 2017. Research contributions addressing any aspect of *Overcoming the limits to growth and human development: Managerial Challenges - Asian and European Perspectives* are welcome.

The research conference is a joint undertaking between University of Parma, Italy, University of Pau (Université de Pau et des Pays de l'Adour), France, the Ruhr Universität Bochum, Germany, the School of Asian Studies and Business Management Ca' Foscari University, Venice, The TELECOM Ecole de Management, France, The School of East Asian Studies, University of Sheffield, (U.K), The University of Limerick, Ireland, Yokohama National University, Japan, and Kwansai Gakuin University, Japan.

The Conference is intended to bring together researchers engaged in Management / Economics, Politics Studies and related fields from Europe, Asia and other parts of the World. Doctoral students are also strongly encouraged to submit papers for consideration.

Conference Venue, Conference Fee, Accommodation and travel

The conference will take place at University of Parma, Parma, Italy. The conference fee is **240 €** and includes welcome dinner, two lunches, two dinners, coffee breaks and a copy of the conference proceedings.

Available funding does not allow the organizing committee to provide financial support to participants in relation to accommodation and travel expenses. However, special prices will be negotiated with hotels or academic accommodation facilities located in Parma, close to the conference venue.

Submission Rules

Papers in English should be original and not submitted for publication elsewhere. They may either be related to a particular country or be of a comparative nature. Papers accepted for presentation at the conference will be published as Conference Proceedings. Furthermore, a number of selected papers will be published in scholarly journals or/and books. Proposals for panel sessions will also be considered.

A two-page abstract in English (including bibliography) should be submitted **by December the 15th, 2016** to the following e-mail address: euro-asie@univ-pau.fr. A title page with a complete list of authors, their academic position, addresses, phone and fax numbers as well as E-mail should be included separately. The decision of the Scientific Committee will be communicated to the authors by January 15th, 2017. **The final paper**, including an abstract of around 300 words, should be forwarded **by April the 28th, 2017**. Length should not exceed 6,000 words or 15 single-spaced pages (including tables, figures, and references). Papers should be submitted by e-mail as an attachment to Mrs LOUMAGNE and GUENEBAUD at euro-asie@univ-pau.fr.
